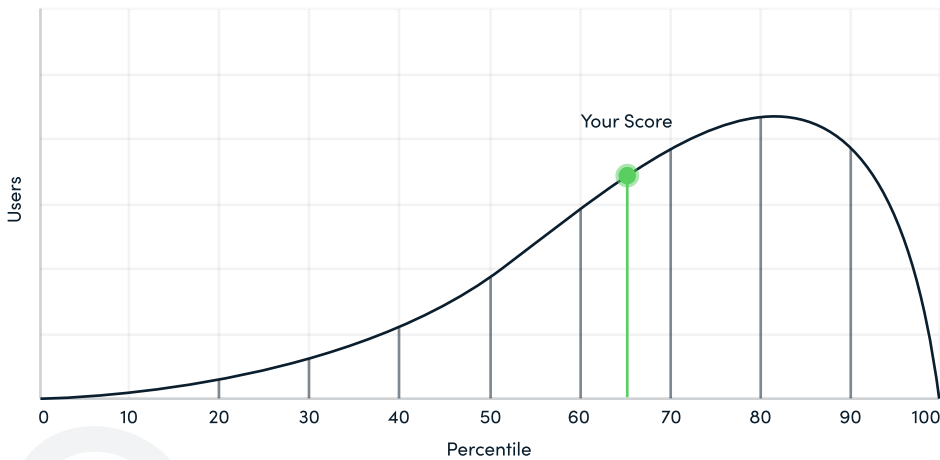
This means that you would perform **very well** in careers where your abstract reasoning abilities will be put to good use.

The sten score is a standardized score on a 10-point scale where 1 indicates low performance and 10 indicates high performance. It has a mean of 5.5 and a standard deviation of 2. For example, if you scored lower than 5.5, it means you scored below average; if you scored higher than 5.5, then you scored above average.

## Your T-score is 50.

The T-score is a standardized score ranging between 20 and 80 with a mean of 50 and a standard deviation of 10. It indicates how far your score is from the mean. For example, if you have a T-score of 60, it's one standard deviation above the mean.

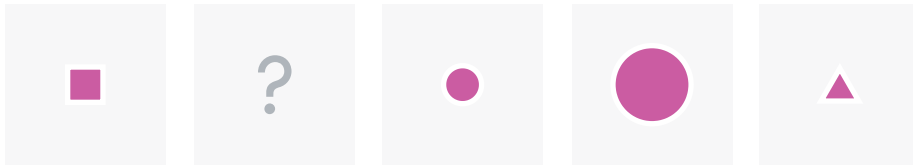
## You scored 13% above the median.

The median raw score of all other test-takers on CareerHunter is currently 57%, meaning you scored 13% above the average.

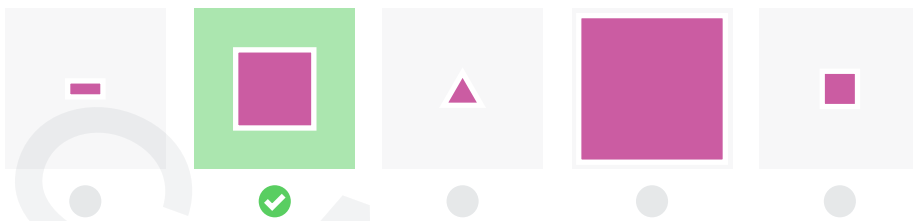

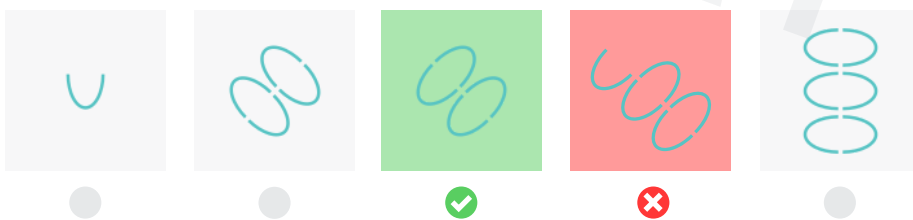
Which of the following images completes the sequence?



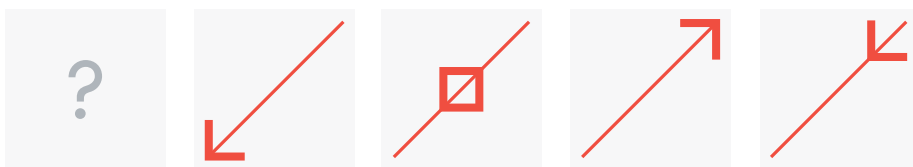
**Q2. Incorrect**



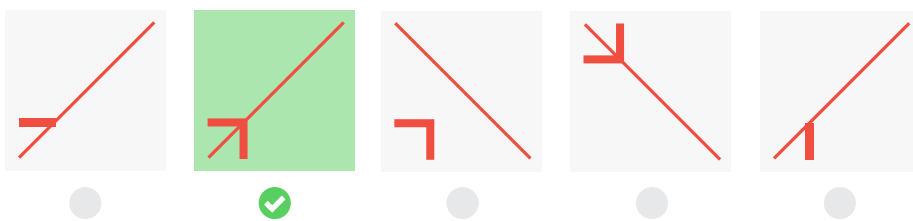
Which of the following images completes the sequence?

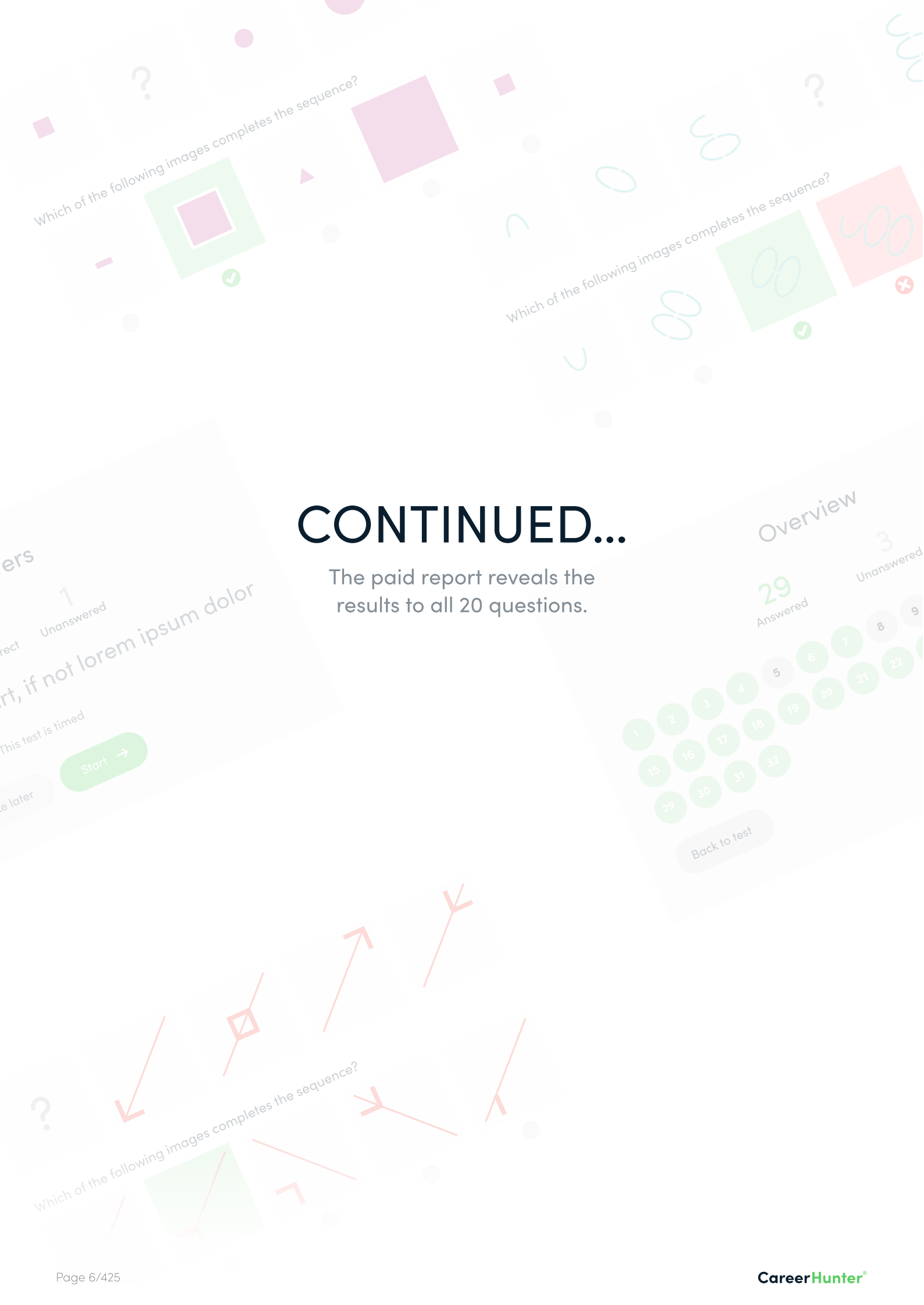

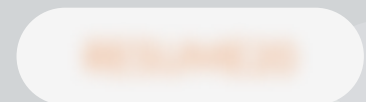
